Case studies



Archbishop Tenison C of E High School

Working with Croydon Council to identify schools where significant energy and carbon savings could be achieved Lantern shortlisted Archbishop Tenison CofE High School as a potential candidate for renewable heating solutions.



Lantern analysed the school's energy consumption and presented four scenarios for using biomass heating. Two of these included a 10% reduction in energy consumption through low cost energy efficiency measures.

Using the Lantern data analysis - including boiler replacement costs and possible energy savings - the school and local council will be able to make an informed decision when the current boilers are replaced.

Lady Margaret Primary School

Lady Margaret Primary School in Southall wanted to understand the school's environmental impact. They were also keen to learn more about wider sustainability issues (climate change, waste and energy), and how they relate to the national curriculum and everyday school life.

Lantern calculated the school ecological and carbon footprints to identify where the school's biggest impacts were and facilitated a workshop with senior staff, students, teachers and governors. The workshop generated ideas which formed the basis for the environmental action plan.

Lantern is providing ongoing support to Lady Margaret to implement the action plan, including developing science week classroom activities linked to the national curriculum.
